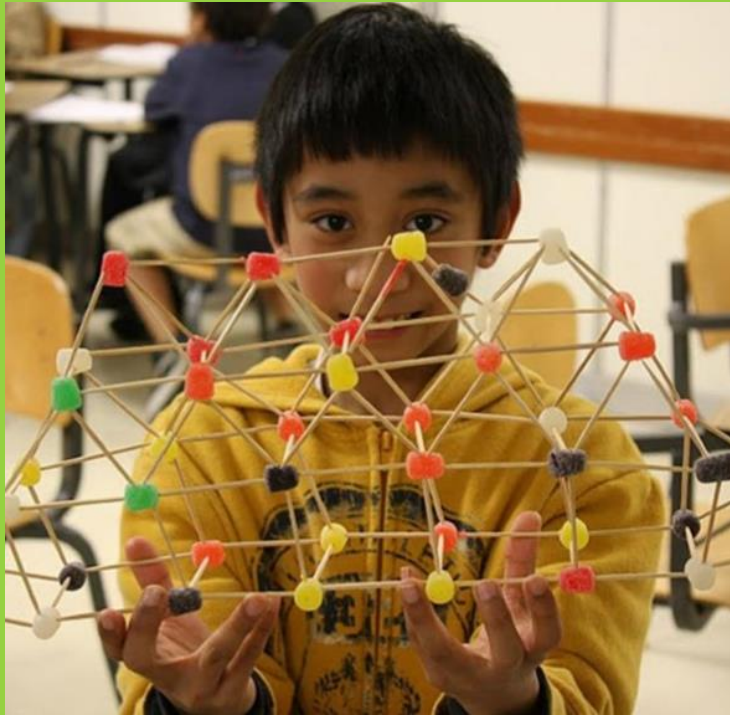


GatorTRAX Fall 2018

3. Teach kids mathematics using practical real-world examples in project driven sessions

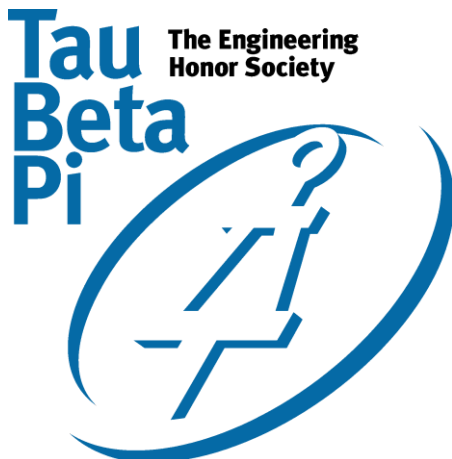
