Parade Float Rules

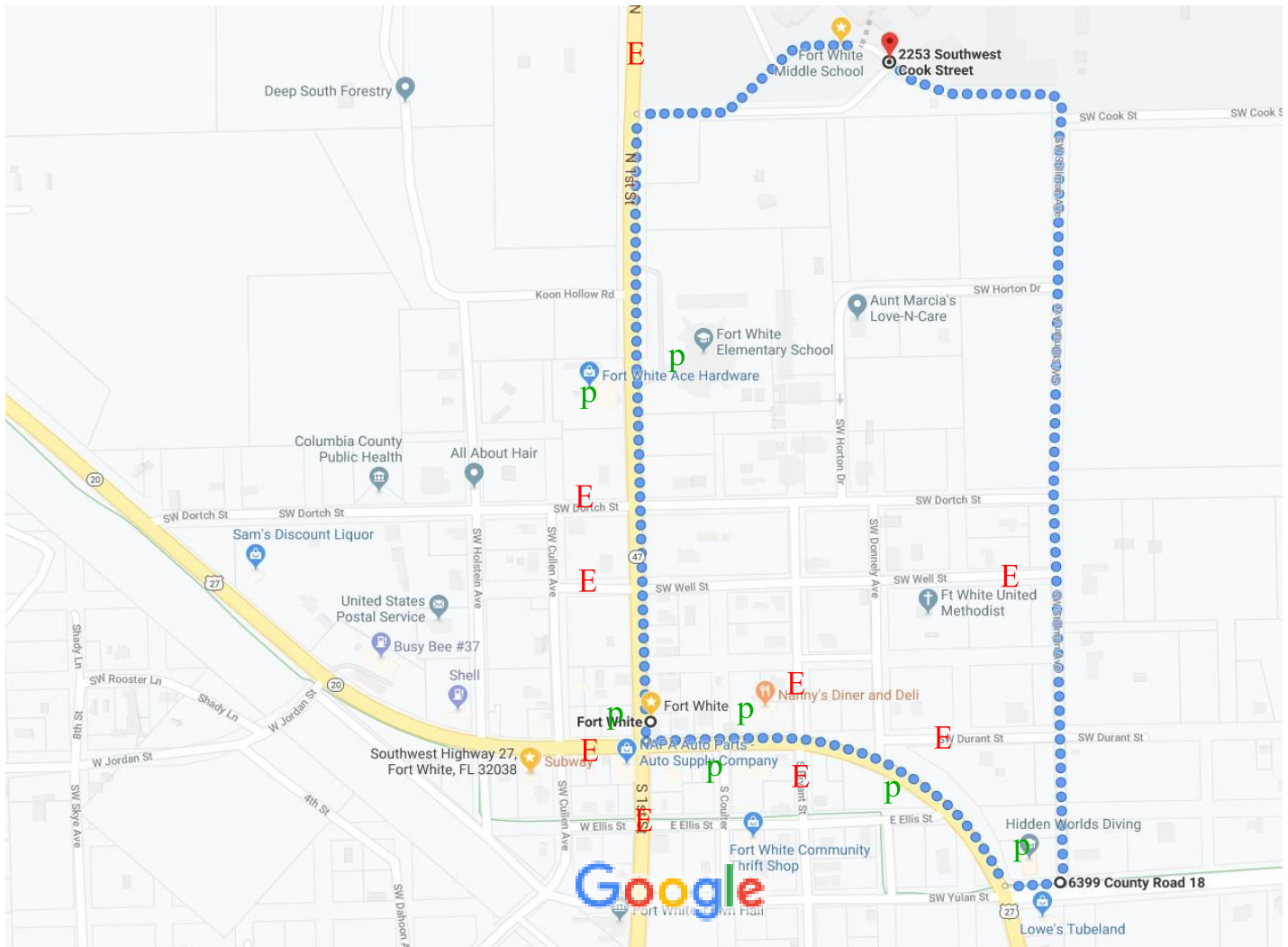
1. The organizers of this parade reserve the right to accept or reject any parade applicant. Parade participants must follow the instructions from the parade staff. Parade staff reserves the right to remove any unit from the line-up for any reason or cause without advance notice.
2. No candy or other items can be thrown during the parade. Walkers may hand out these items if desired.
3. Alcoholic beverages and other controlled substances and smoking are forbidden on and along the parade route. This includes all staging and disband areas. Participants consuming said substances prior to or during the parade will not be allowed to participate and will be removed from the line -up 4.All floats must be of the "pull behind" type on a trailer.
5. There must be a responsible adults present if any children are riding or walking with the float.
6. All vehicles and/or vehicles pulling a float will have a dry chemical ABC rated fire extinguisher of at least 5-lb capacity. The extinguisher can be in the tow vehicle or on the float.
7. Drivers of motorized vehicles must be at least 18 years of age and have a valid driver license. Proof of insurance is required for all vehicles.
8. No real weapons / fire arms allowed, except by law enforcement, on any float entry.
9. No fire or flame-producing devices are allowed on floats. No fireworks or pyrotechnics are allowed.
10. Float must be decorated on all four sides.
11. You are responsible for your entry and following the rules and guidelines. The rules and guidelines will be signed by the person in charge of the entry and must be in their possession at the time of inspection. A signed copy of the rules and guidelines must be attached to the signed application.
12. ***IMPORTANT*** If an emergency vehicle approaches during the parade ALL floats will pull over to the right as far as possible. If the float will block an intersection the float will turn right at the intersection and pull over to the right as far as possible after clearing the intersection. The parade will continue after all emergency vehicles have passed. Floats that turned will continue around the block and rejoin the parade from the rear. ***IMPORTANT***
