Research activities include:

- an MRI scan
- sensory & motor games
- an Autism Diagnostic Observation Schedule

Your child may be eligible if they

- ~ are a boy between 6 years - 8 years, 6 months of age
- ~ have a diagnosis of autism from an MD, psychiatrist, neurologist, or psychologist
- ~ are able to attend OT sessions 2 times per week at UF over a 12-week period of time

Participants will receive:

- up to \$120
- 12 weeks of no cost OT intervention
