Research activities include:


- an MRI scan

- have a diagnosis of autism from an MD, psychiatrist, neurologist, or psychologist
- ~ are able to attend OT sessions 2 times per week at UF over a 12-week period of time



- up to \$120
- 12 weeks of no cost OT intervention
